Methodology

The Indigenous Equity Ownership Tracker (IEOT) is a proprietary data tool developed to monitor and document Indigenous equity ownership in major resource and energy projects across Canada. The tracker is maintained through continuous desktop research and data aggregation from publicly available sources. Our data collection process includes reviewing and verifying information from:

- Press releases from project proponents and Indigenous partners
- Financial statements and investor disclosures
- Government announcements and regulatory filings
- Company websites and investor presentations
- News articles from reputable media sources
- Financial and industry reports
- Open-source data repositories

Only publicly known projects are included in the tracker. We strive to ensure the accuracy and comprehensiveness of our data by updating the tracker as new information becomes available. However, given the dynamic nature of project developments and the possibility of unannounced agreements, some projects may not be captured, and some information may be outdated or inaccurate.

The tracker includes all publicly known major projects with Indigenous equity ownership in the following sectors:

- Oil & Gas
- Mining & Critical Minerals
- CCUS (Carbon Capture, Utilization, and Storage)
- Chemicals & Fuels
- Power & Utilities (Includes all projects greater than or equal to 0.5 MW)
