Indigenous Resource Payment Tracker (IRPT)



The IRPT is a database and interactive dashboard that tracks all reported payments made by resource companies to Indigenous governments for the commercial development of oil, gas, and minerals across Canada since 2017. It aggregates thousands of Extractive Sector Transparency Measures Act (ESTMA) reports to unlock never-before-seen insights.

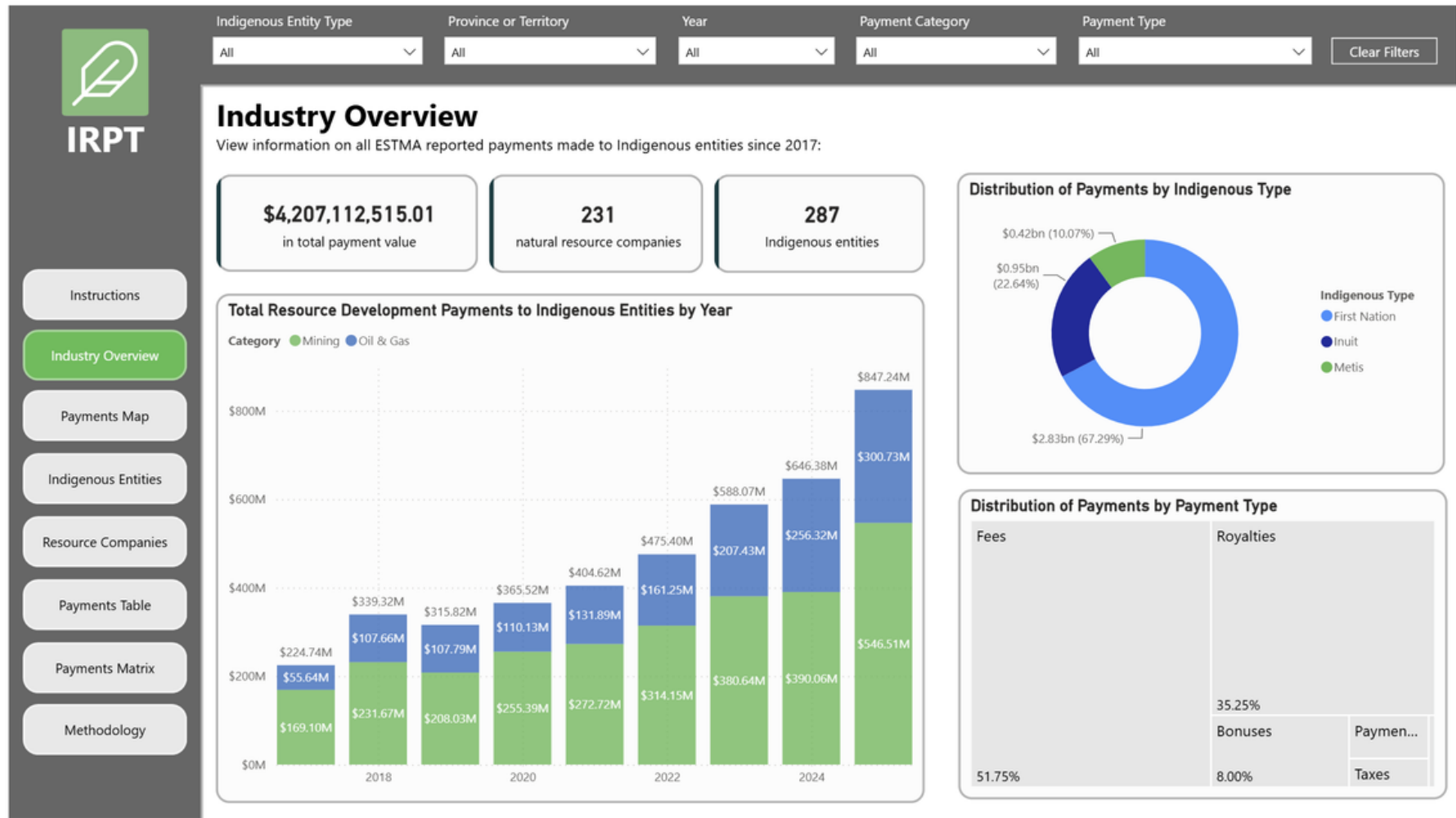

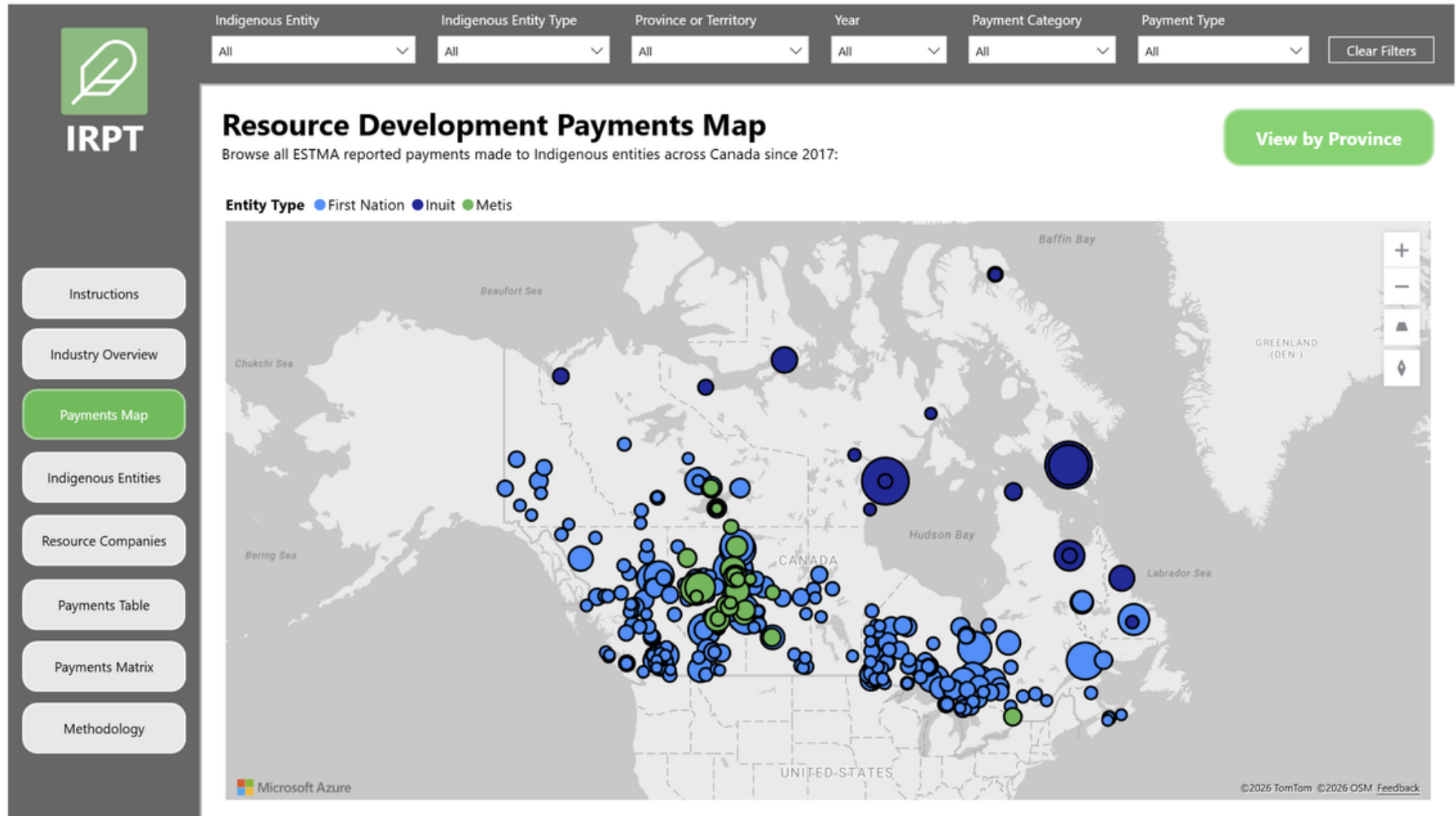


Our platform is trusted by industry, Indigenous organizations, policymakers, and investors for comprehensive and up-to-date data on Indigenous participation in energy and resource development.

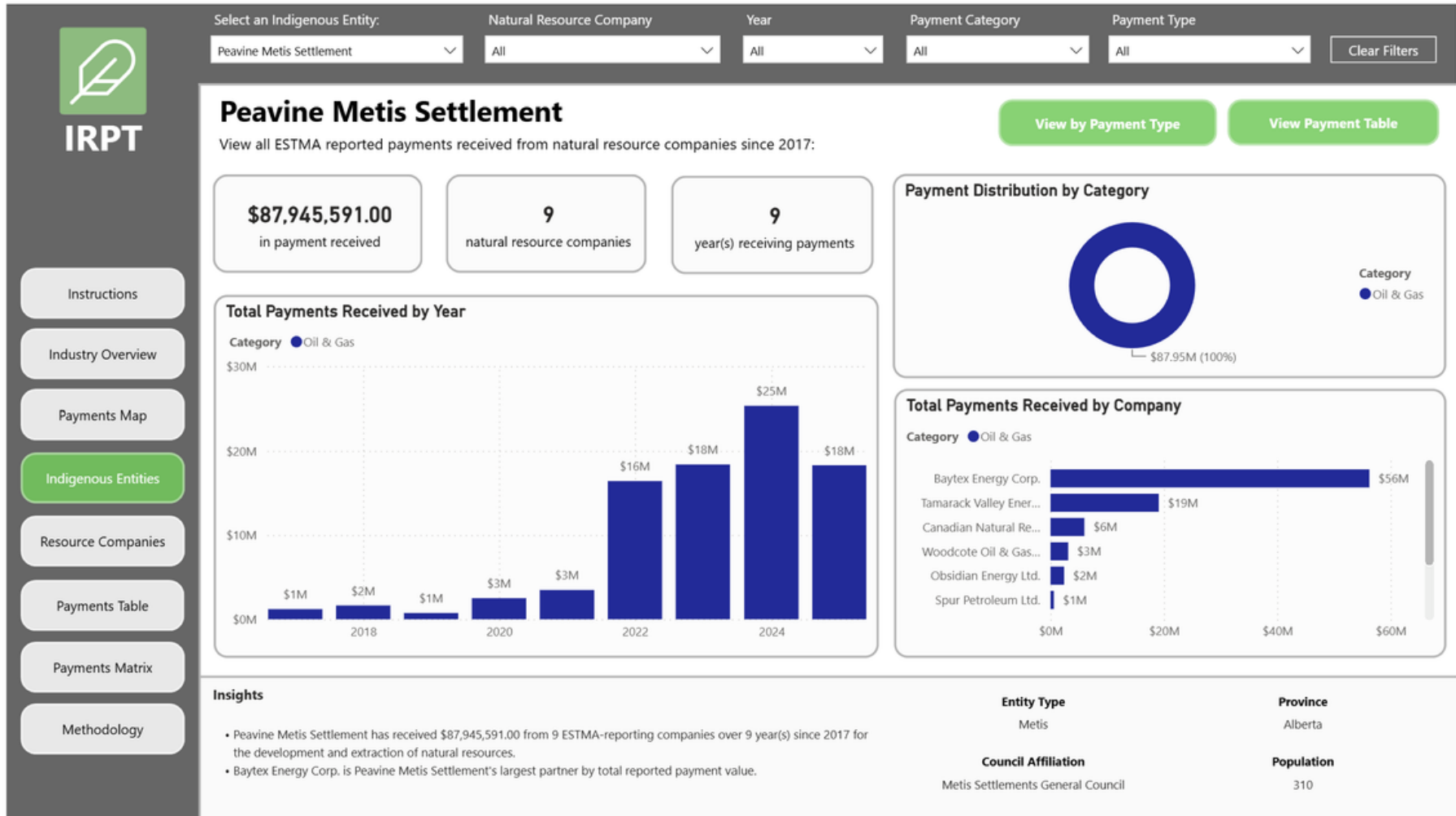
